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NAIROBI EXCURSION

After breakfast, drive to the Nairobi Museum located at the Museum hill approximately 10 minutes drive from the city centre. It is the flagship museum of National Museums of Kenya, housing some of the most celebrated collections of history, culture and art from Kenya and East Africa. Visit the snake park located next to the national museum of Kenya.

Drive to the animal orphanage and later on visit the Nairobi safari walk.

Nairobi Animal Orphanage is the oldest animal orphanage in Kenya and set in Nairobi National Park with lush vegetation contrasting against the red dust and clay of the soil. This important educational and training facility, which is housed, in the only wildlife protected area in a capital city in the world is often home to more than 20 different animals and bird species.

Nairobi safari walk is Kenya's new conservation based recreation facility. The combination of skilled and creative landscape design, unique wildlife species and detailed interpretation, renders the facility supremacy in tourism and conservation education.



You will then be driven to Carnivore restaurant for lunch. The Carnivore is considered 'Africa's Greatest Eating Experience'. This open-air meat specialty restaurant has strikingly different food, service and atmosphere to anything ever seen in Kenya. Every type of meat imaginable, including four choices of wild game, are roasted on traditional Masai swords over a huge,



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visually spectacular charcoal pit that dominates the entrance of the restaurant. The waiters then carry these swords around the restaurant, carving unlimited amounts of the prime meats onto sizzling, cast iron plates in front of you. A wide selection of salads, vegetable side dishes, and a variety of exotic sauces accompany the meat feast. Dessert and coffee follow this

After lunch, drive to the Bomas of Kenya, a tourist village in Langata, Nairobi. Bomas (homesteads) displays traditional villages belonging to the several Kenyan tribes.

It was established by the government to preserve, maintain and promote rich and diverse cultural values of various tribal groups of Kenya.



It is located next to the game filled Nairobi National Park. Bomas of Kenya presents various dances depicting different ethnic groups of Kenya between 1430hrs -1600hrs from Monday to Friday and between 1530hrs - 1715 hrs on Saturday, Sunday and public holidays. After enjoying different dances from Kenya, drive back to your hotel
